

2022 COMMUNITY BENEFIT SNAPSHOT

**Providence Hood River Memorial Hospital

In 2022, Providence Oregon continued its tradition of compassion and dedication to our communities, with Providence Hood River Memorial Hospital investing more than \$8.2 million to improve community health. These targeted investments included \$1.3 million in community health services and \$3.7 million in free and low-cost care.

PROVIDENCE INVESTS IN OREGON'S HEALTH

PROVIDING COUNSELING AND SERVICES FOR LATINX YOUTH

In 2022, Providence provided funds for The Next Door to expand the organization's counseling and substance use disorder treatment services for Latinx youth in the Columbia Gorge. The grant helped fund a bilingual, dual-diagnosis clinician who has since served the mental health needs of 24 new Latinx youth clients ages 4 to 26, providing a total of 351 services.

HELPING PEOPLE IN NEED WITH HOUSING AND CARE

As part of a project with Mid-Columbia Community Action Council and the Columbia Gorge Health Council's Bridges to Health Pathways program, Providence helped fund a bilingual community health worker to support homeless community members. Since September 2022, more than 27 people experiencing homelessness received assistance finding stable housing, health care and social services through customized case management and community care coordination.

SUPPORTING THE NEEDS OF OLDER ADULTS

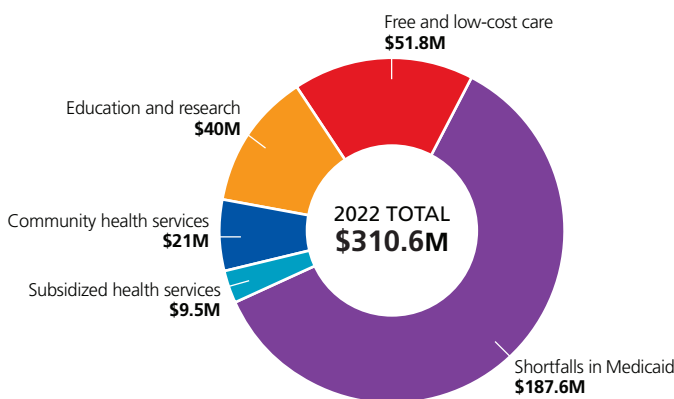
Providence awarded a grant to AGE+ and Hood River Valley Adult Center to transition the Volunteers in Action program. Now called Circles of Care, the program matches volunteers with elderly clients needing support. Since the transition, 38 volunteers assisted 55 older adults with support that included transportation to medical appointments and stores, and help with household chores and social activities.

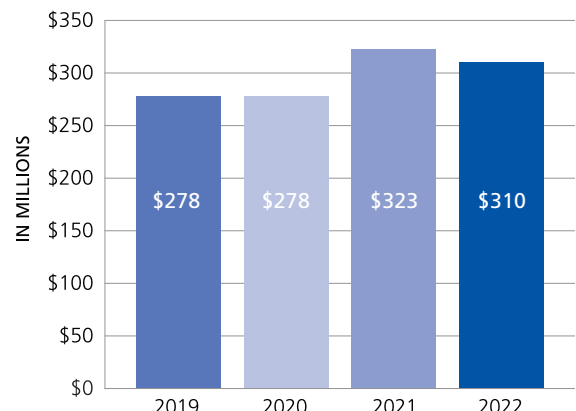
