	Code Red (Fire) To be initiated when you see fire or smoke or smell something burning.
	Code Blue (Respiratory/ Cardiac Arrest) To be initiated when someone stops breathing or heart stops
	Code Orange (Hazardous spill) To be initiated when hazardous material is spilled
State of the state	Code Gray (Combative Person) To be initiated when someone is combative or threatening someone
	Code Silver (Weapon) To be initiated when someone has a weapon and you are concerned about your own safety or the safety of others
	Amber Alert (Abduction) To be initiated when a patient is missing or you fear there is an abduction/kidnapping
(** <u>*</u>	Rapid Response Team (Clinical Response) To be initiated when you have concerns about the abrupt change in your patient's condition and you need additional help to assess patient. An ICU nurse, RT and Hospitalist will respond.
	External Triage (Mass Casualty) House supervisor will call
	Internal Triage (Internal Event) To be initiated when there is an internal emergency. (examples: bomb threat, loss of medical gas, flood on hospital unit) Administration will determine the best method of communication based on event issue. Note: This code may not be called overhead depending on subject matter.
	Code Clear To be initiated when code is cleared.
