### Notes from the PMMC Clinical Coordinator-

- Complete and submit the regional student requirements (student packet) in a timely way so all clearance and preparations can be made prior to your arrival. After approval, these clearances do not expire until your date of graduation.

- Patient assignments-
  - It is the responsibility of the instructor to get the assignments for students. The instructor meets with unit Charge RN the day before students are assigned on a shift, the instructor then disseminates the information to students. Please do not go to the unit prior to your assigned clinical day.
