As a health care leader, Providence Health & Services is committed to providing a safe, healthy and clean environment for all persons, and maintaining a positive community image.

1. The use of smokable materials, in any form, is prohibited on Providence property.
 2. The smokable free policy applies to:
 - a. All caregivers, students, patients, visitors, vendors, and contractors.
 - b. All smokable materials.
 - i) Smokable Materials includes all tobacco and marijuana products. This includes but is not limited to: cigarettes, cigars, pipes, all forms of smokeless tobacco products, electronic cigarettes and other methods of inhaling smoke-like vapors, marijuana and any other material that may be smoke
 3. Smokable materials waste must be disposed of safely in receptacles. Littering and offensive odors (including the smell of smokable materials) in the workplace will not be tolerated.
- 2) Students are responsible for:
- a. Abiding by Smoke/Tobacco Free Policy
