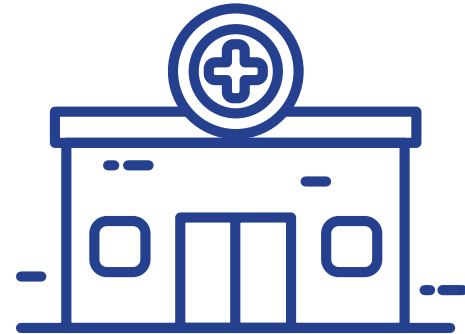


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 Personalized care for health and well-being

- ✓ Burns
- ✓ Bites
- ✓ Bronchitis and pneumonia
- ✓ Sprains and broken bones
- ✓ Asthma and allergic reactions
- ✓ Minor cuts needing stitches

HOSPITAL EMERGENCY ROOM

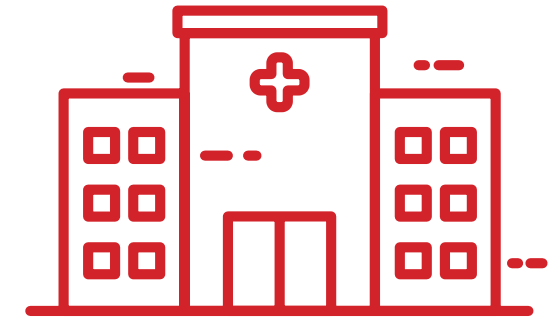


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 Sudden and severe illnesses and injuries that may be life-threatening

- ✓ Difficulty breathing
- ✓ Difficulty speaking
- ✓ Severe chest pain
- ✓ Bleeding that won't stop
- ✓ Seizures
- ✓ Sudden, severe stomach pain

FREESTANDING EMERGENCY ROOM



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 Sudden and severe illnesses and injuries; can cause delayed care

- ✗ Not recommended for stroke patients
- ✗ Not recommended for heart attack patients
- ✗ Not recommended for trauma care
- ✗ No immediate access to blood bank
- ✗ No immediate access to operating room or on-call surgeons
- ✗ No immediate access to pediatric or main intensive care unit
