# **Cleaning and Disinfection of Probes**

#### **PURPOSE:**

To ensure proper reprocessing of probes to prevent cross contamination and damage to the probe.

#### POLICY:

- · All probes will undergo a thorough manual cleaning followed by high level disinfection.
- All personnel involved with the reprocessing of probes will be trained in the proper methods according to the manufacturers reprocessing directions.
- Personal Protective Equipment will be worn for the safety of staff involved with the cleaning and disinfection process.
- All probes will be documented with the patient information on whom it was used.

#### **REPROCESSING PROBES:**

There are a variety of manufacturers, types, and models of probes. Consult the manufacturers recommendations for reprocessing.

Reprocessing of probes includes the following steps:

- 1. Manual cleaning
- 2. Rinsing
- 3. Perform High Level Disinfection
- 4. Rinsing
- 5. Drying
- 6. Leak testing will be done if required
