PURPOSE:

The purpose of this Policy is to outline the types of packaging used to process items in SPD.

POLICY:

Disposable packaging:

- Only packaging approved by the FDA shall be used. Non-woven, disposable materials are recommended.
 This can include polypropylene wrap, steam peel pouches, and vaporized hydrogen peroxide peel pouches.
- 2. Method of packaging depends on the item and the manufacturers IFU's.
- 3. Wraps should be double ply. If using single ply wraps, be sure to wrap the item twice.
- 4. Envelope style wrapping and tamper proof tape will be used to ensure sterility.
- 5. Check packaging for all possible quality issues.

Details are to be included in the department's Standard Work Instructions.

Non-disposable packaging:

- 1. Aluminum and plastic canisters are forms of non-disposable packaging.
- 2. Canisters are to be in good condition with no dents or fractures.
- 3. Canisters are to be chosen based off of size and manufacturer's IFU's.
- 4. Tamper proof locks will be used to ensure sterility.
- 5. Details are to be included in the department's Standard Work Instructions.
