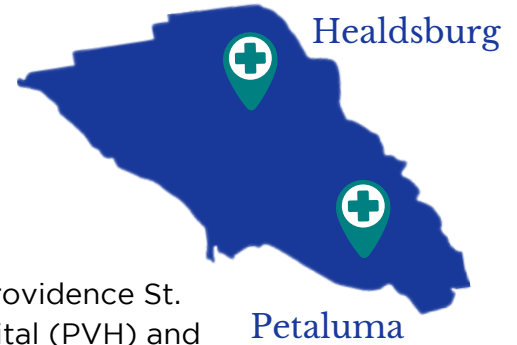


NorCal HealthConnect

Petaluma Valley Hospital has been operated by a subsidiary of Providence St. Joseph Health for more than 20 years and has been recognized for its award-winning care. NorCal HealthConnect is committed to investing in the future of PVH and HDH and the desire to find long-term stability for the Sonoma region.

Final approval of the sale goes before area voters on Nov. 3, 2020, as Measures BB and CC.
