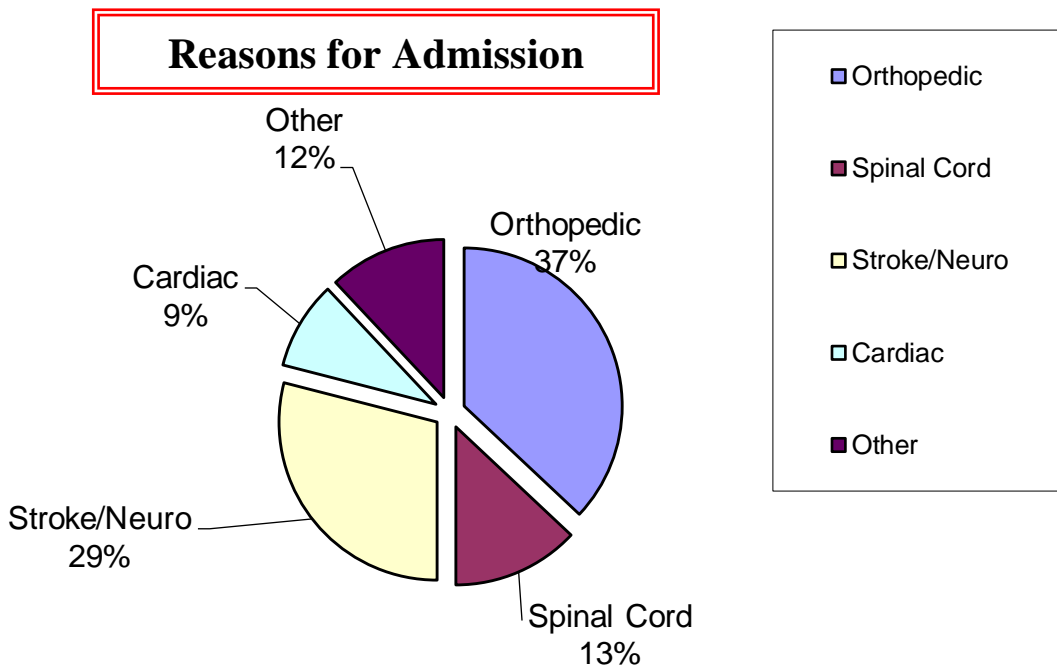


# St. Joseph Hospital Acute Inpatient Rehab Report Card 2020

## Average Length of Stay (days)

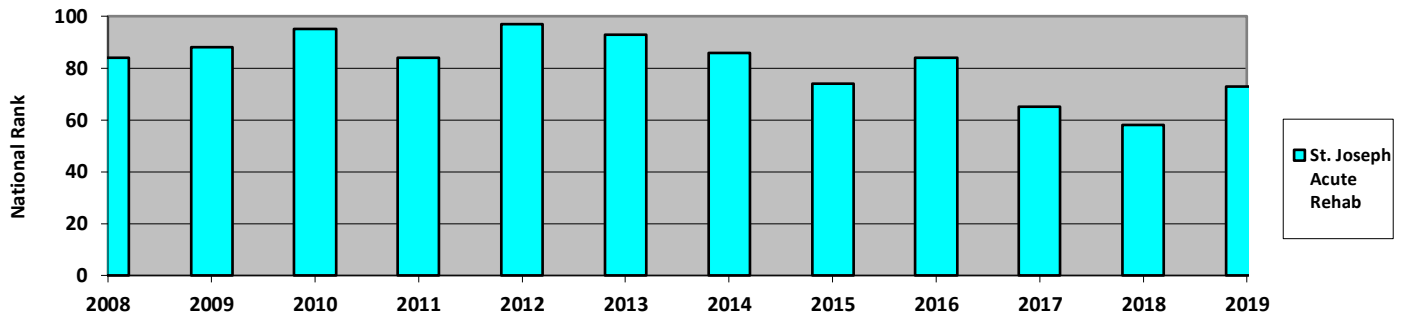

## Average Age

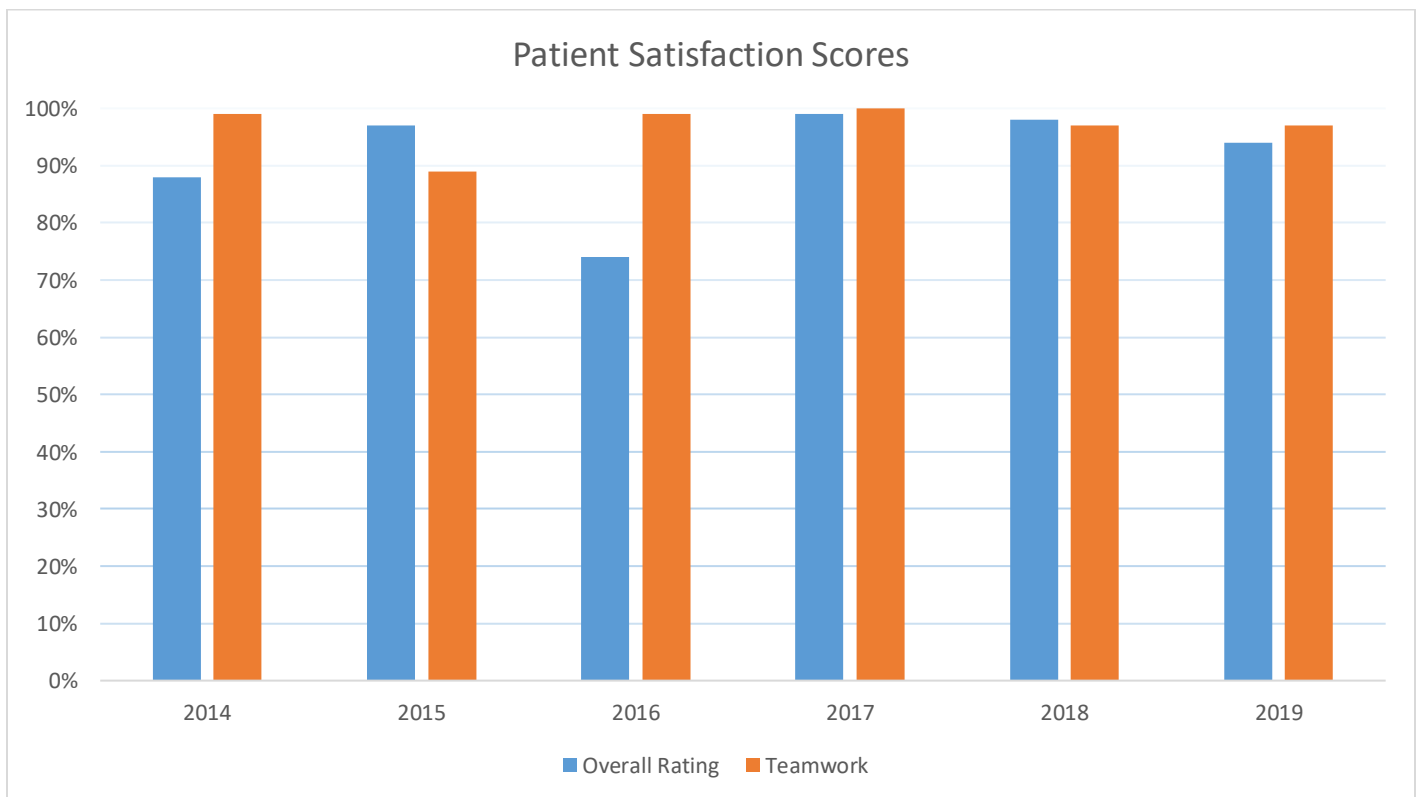
