Providence Medford Medical Center and communities



In 2021, Providence Oregon continued its tradition of compassion and dedication to our communities, with Providence Medford Medical Center investing more than \$64.2 million to improve community health. These targeted investments included \$3.9 million in community health services and \$5.8 million in free and low-cost care.

PROVIDENCE INVESTS IN OREGON'S HEALTH

SUPPORTING COVID-19 VACCINATION IN THE LATINX COMMUNITY

To help support COVID-19 vaccination efforts for high-risk populations, Providence awarded a \$65,000 grant to La Clinica, a Federally Qualified Health Center. La Clinica was able to offer vaccinations to the local Latinx community, with a special focus on agricultural workers. Through a patient-centered and trauma-informed approach, La Clinica provides outreach and services in a culturally appropriate manner.

FEEDING FAMILIES EXPERIENCING FOOD INSECURITY

In response to the combined traumas of the Alameda fire and COVID pandemic, in 2021 Providence supported the Rogue Valley Farm to Families free produce box program. For three months, more than 150 primarily Latinx households (totaling more than 1,000 individuals) from the Phoenix-Talent school district received weekly boxes of fresh organic produce and other food staples.

CREATING HOUSING FOR PEOPLE IN NEED


Providence partnered with Rogue Retreat and the City of Medford to increase emergency and transitional housing for people in need. Providence funding helped refurbish rooms at a local repurposed motel through Project Turnkey. Providence also partnered with Rogue Retreat to support the Urban Campground, providing shelter and health services for community members who would otherwise be living on the streets.
