Providence Seaside Hospital and communities



In 2021, Providence Oregon continued its tradition of compassion and dedication to our communities, with Providence Seaside Hospital investing more than \$19.8 million to improve community health. These targeted investments included \$1.3 million in community health services and \$2.1 million in free and low-cost care.

PROVIDENCE INVESTS IN OREGON'S HEALTH

PROVIDING HOUSING ASSISTANCE FOR : OPENING DOORS TO MENTAL HEALTH **THOSE IN NEED**

Providence helped fund the Clatsop Community Action housing assistance program in 2021. The program helped hundreds of the community's most vulnerable people receive rental assistance and other support. With Clatsop County's rate of homelessness more than six times higher than the rest of Oregon, CCA works to secure and maintain housing for unsheltered populations or those at risk of becoming homeless.

SUPPORT AND RESOURCES

To help address growing mental health care needs in Clatsop County, Providence provided seed money through grants to Beacon Clubhouse. For people navigating mental illness, this low-barrier peer-run center helps members with housing assistance and with getting out of abusive relationships, as well as helping them get connected to health care providers, job training resources and local social services.

SUPPORTING FUTURE HEALTH **CARE LEADERS**


In partnership with Clatsop Community College, Providence funded health care diversity scholarships for students enrolled in certificate or degree programs related to health care. Scholarships were awarded to 10 students, prioritizing students from underrepresented ethnic backgrounds, bilingual students and first-generation college students. Providence also helped the school develop career paths for students in health care.
