

2022 COMMUNITY BENEFIT SNAPSHOT

**Providence Seaside Hospital
and communities**



In 2022, Providence Oregon continued its tradition of compassion and dedication to our communities, with Providence Seaside Hospital investing more than \$3.7 million to improve community health. These targeted investments included more than \$912,000 in community health services and \$1.9 million in free and low-cost care.

PROVIDENCE INVESTS IN OREGON'S HEALTH

CREATING AFFORDABLE AND SUPPORTIVE HOUSING

With housing availability and affordability at crisis levels in Clatsop County, Providence contributed funding to help Columbia Pacific Coordinated Care Organization convert Seaside's Red Lion Hotel into 55 units of housing. When the project is completed, it will include affordable housing for health care workers as well as supportive housing for people in northwest Oregon experiencing behavioral health challenges.

BUILDING ECONOMIC STABILITY THROUGH CHILDCARE ACCESS

A lack of access to childcare for working parents in Clatsop County prompted Providence to join with local partners in funding expanded care opportunities. The initiative included creating greater childcare access and affordability for diverse income levels, improving culturally appropriate services and supporting professional development for childcare providers. In its first six months, the project helped add 137 new childcare slots.

HELPING BREAK THE CYCLE OF ABUSE


In 2022, Providence funding helped The Harbor expand its shelter program in Clatsop County for people experiencing domestic violence. The non-profit organization added dedicated staff to assist individuals and families leave abusive situations and find safe and permanent housing. The Harbor offered special support to the Latinx community, helping them overcome language barriers, discrimination and other obstacles to securing housing.


