<p>New Protocol Review: #173 A phase 1 study to evaluate the safety of KLN-1010, a novel, in vivo gene therapy to generate anti-BCMA CAR-T cells in patients with relapsed and refractory multiple myeloma.</p>	<p>NIH Guidelines Section: III-C-1, III-D-1-a, and III-D-3</p> <p>The studies’ primary objective is to determine the safety, tolerability, maximum tolerated dose (MTD), and/or recommended Phase 2 does (RP2D) of KLN-1010. KLN-1010 is a pseudotyped third-generation, self-inactivating (SIN), replication-incompetent, recombinant lentivirus.</p> <p>Committee discussed the study and had a few minor recommended edits.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) I.1: Add III-D-3 and III-C-1 2) I.3: Define RCL. 3) II:5: Add an additional layer for transport, a hard-sided, leak proof container with a biohazard symbol on the exterior in accordance with the requirements of the OSHA Bloodborne Pathogen Standard. 4) III.12,13,14: Add masking to PPE required. 5) IV.15: Bleach should not be used in a BSC unless followed immediately with a water rinse due to corrosion. Instead of bleach, use an appropriate disinfectant such as quaternary ammonium compounds, hydrogen peroxide-based disinfectants or chlorine dioxide. 6) V. 16: Define IMP. 	<p>Motion to approve with administrative edits, seconded, and approved.</p>
