

High Reliability Class Registration Instructions: EMPLOYED Professional Staff and Allied Health Providers

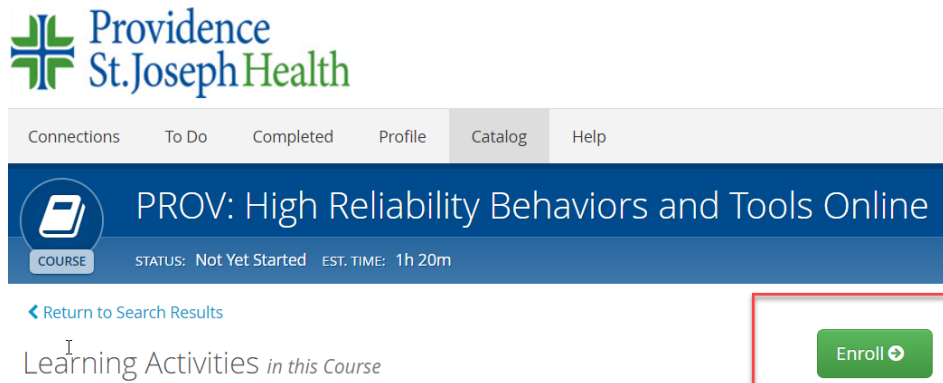
Professional Staff are required to complete the High Reliability Behaviors and Tools online training within 90 days of appointment.
