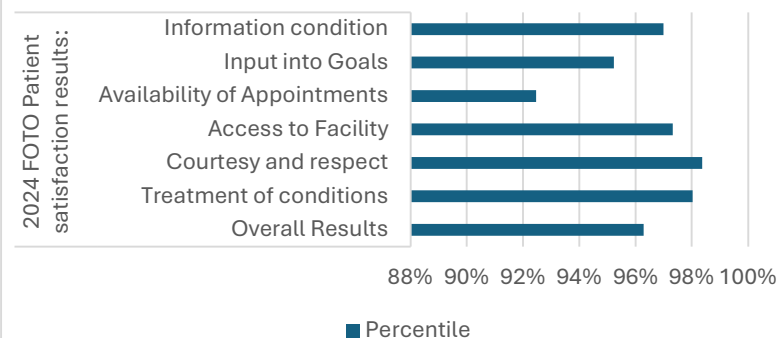


OUTPATIENT INTEGRATED BRAIN INJURY PROGRAM (IBIP) Outcome Report: Jan-Dec 2024

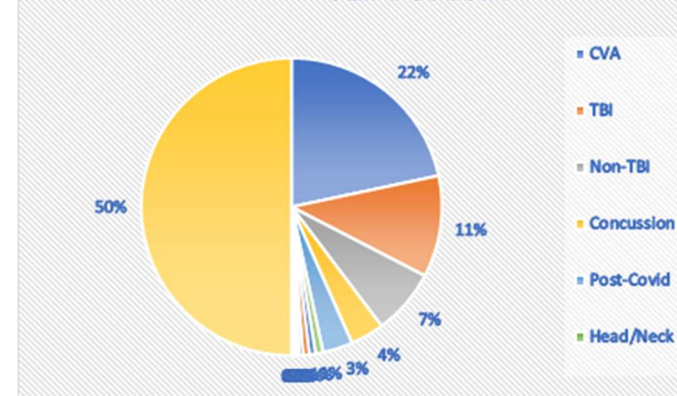
Program Description:

The Mission Hospital Outpatient Integrated Brain Injury Program (IBIP) is a functional therapeutic program for individuals recovering from a trauma or neurological event. The Outpatient Integrated Brain Injury Program provides assessment and treatment in a variety of areas to enable persons served to re-integrate into a productive lifestyle. The program is available to people who were previously independent but require continued physical and cognitive rehabilitation. The persons served can participate in up to three hours of therapy services and community-based activities. Our integrated team model is focused on functional recovery that extends from the hospital to the community.

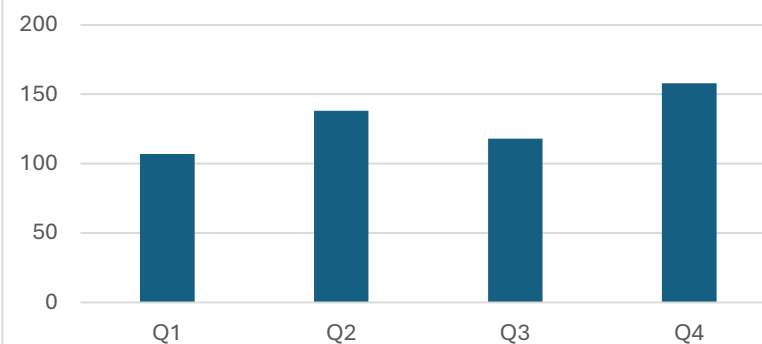
Patient Satisfaction Scores - 2024



Jan-Dec 2024

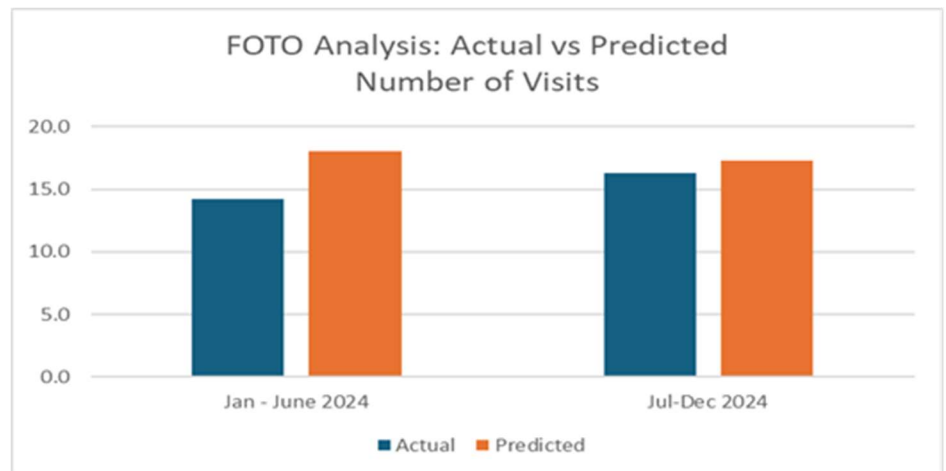
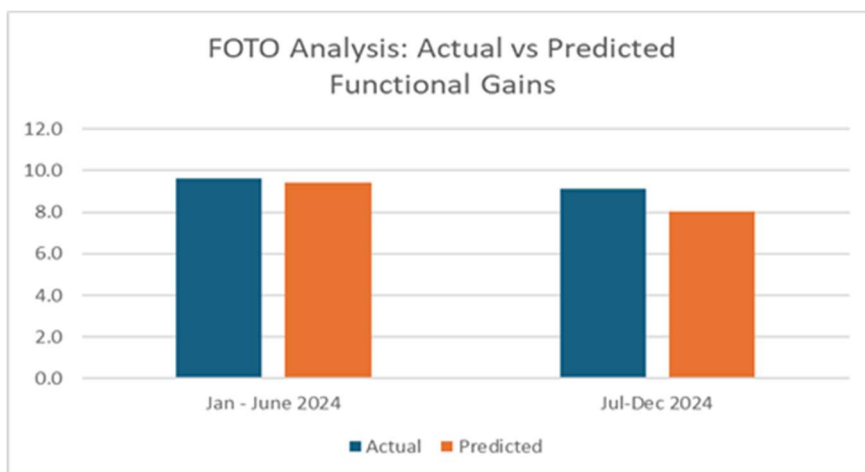


IBIP Participant Volume - 2024

The data for the IBIP program indicated that functional gains exceeded predictions, with actual gains recorded at 9.37 compared to the forecasted 8.71. This favorable outcome surpasses expectations and suggests beneficial advancements. Additionally, the assessment of program efficiency demonstrated a variance between anticipated and actual results. The predicted efficiency was estimated at 17.64 days, whereas actual efficiency was achieved in 15.26 days. This discrepancy implies that the program functioned more effectively than initially anticipated, accomplishing tasks and reaching objectives in a shorter timeframe than projected.

Within the framework of the IBIP program, a significant milestone was achieved as 69% of the total 357 referrals not only commenced treatment but also successfully completed the program. This accomplishment underscores the program's effectiveness in engaging and supporting participants throughout the entire treatment process. The successful completion rate highlights the dedication of both the participants and the program facilitators in working towards positive outcomes. By providing comprehensive support and tailored interventions, the program has effectively addressed the needs of a majority of its referrals, paving the way for long-term success and stability in the individuals' lives.
