### **Focus**

Dr. Les Holve put together the Saint John's Team over 55 years ago establishing a coordinated collaboration of multiple specialties to manage the issues that arise from birth to adulthood for a child with a cleft. This annual symposium, also his creation, will focus on the strategies and expected treatments throughout all of the stages of childhood.

The COVID-19 pandemic interrupted more than a few things in our lives. Healthcare had to adapt to fight this menace as well as continue to serve our patients needing ongoing care.
