Updated Covid Visitation Guidelines

St. Joseph Hospital implemented temporary visitation policies in compliance with the state and the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) mandates. This mandate acknowledged the adverse impacts of visitation restrictions on our patients' physical, mental and emotional well-being. In follow-up consultation regarding our inpatient Covid units and visitation, as of Oct. 4, we are allowing visitation only for end-of-life or special circumstances. This criteria is subject to change as the mandates are updated.

For special circumstances and/or if a priest or religious leader is requesting visitation, please consult with the house supervisor. The full guidelines can be found on our website. The SJO Infection Prevention team and our Patient Experience director will be working with the Covid unit leaders, medical directors and caregiver Unit Based Committees to develop a process that keeps everyone safe and meets the mission/values of our work.




