Search UpToDate to Earn CME

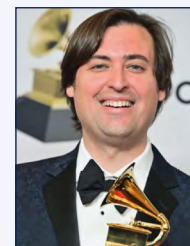
Providence providers have access to UpToDate on the hospital campus, at home or office, and via the UpToDate mobile app. An added benefit: you will earn CME for every topic review read. To access UpToDate at home or via the app:

1. Visit [uptodate.com](https://www.uptodate.com) from a St. Joseph Hospital campus computer, click the orange "Register" button at top right of page, fill out the form and create a username and password (this step must be done on hospital campus).
2. Download the UpToDate app on your mobile device and log in with the username and password you just created to be recognized as a Providence St. Joseph Health user.
3. From your home or office computer visit <https://www.uptodate.com> and log in with the username and password you created.
4. CME credits are earned for each topic review read.
5. You'll receive an email every three months reminding you to log into UpToDate while on hospital campus.

SJO ECC Physician's Son Wins a Grammy



Congratulations to Emergency Care Center physician Claudia Gold and her family, who are celebrating her son winning a Grammy on Feb. 5. Michael Repper was nominated with the New York Youth Symphony for Best Orchestral Performance in Classical Music. Repper, music director and conductor, represented the 150-person New York Youth Symphony at the Grammys. The symphony recorded their nominated debut album during the pandemic.

This was the first youth orchestra to win a Grammy. The kids in the ensemble ranged in age from 12 to 22 when they recorded the album during the pandemic's darkest days.

"I'm speechless," Conductor Repper, 32, said backstage after accepting the award. "I have about 97 text messages on my phone that I can't wait to go through – they are flying off the rails with pride in their own work and that brings a tear to my eye."

Dr. Gold is also the current chair of our PQRB Committee and past Emergency Department chair (2018-19). She has been on medical staff since 1993.
