

# Provider: Updating SmartPhrases with ICD-10 Codes (IP)

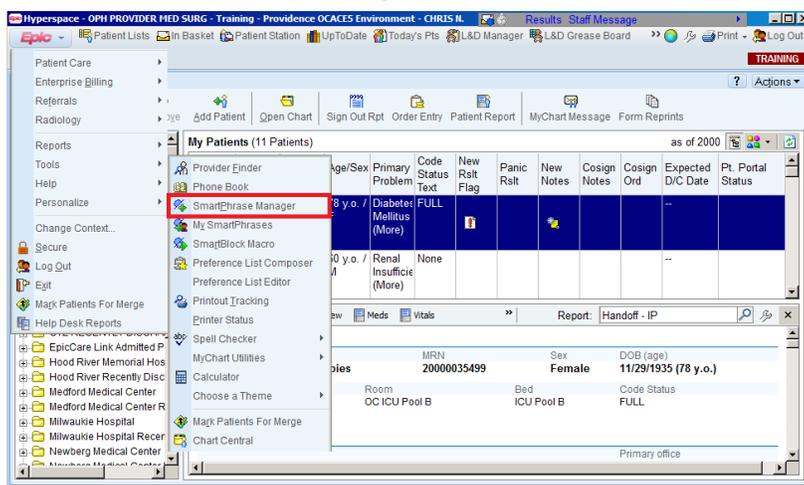
ICD-9 diagnosis codes must be changed to ICD-10 compliant codes in all customized SmartPhrases

Starting on October 1, 2014, customized SmartPhrases that contain ICD-9 diagnosis codes will no longer be valid. Use the following process to use the *SmartPhrase Manager Workbench* to update your SmartPhrases with ICD-10 compliant diagnosis codes.

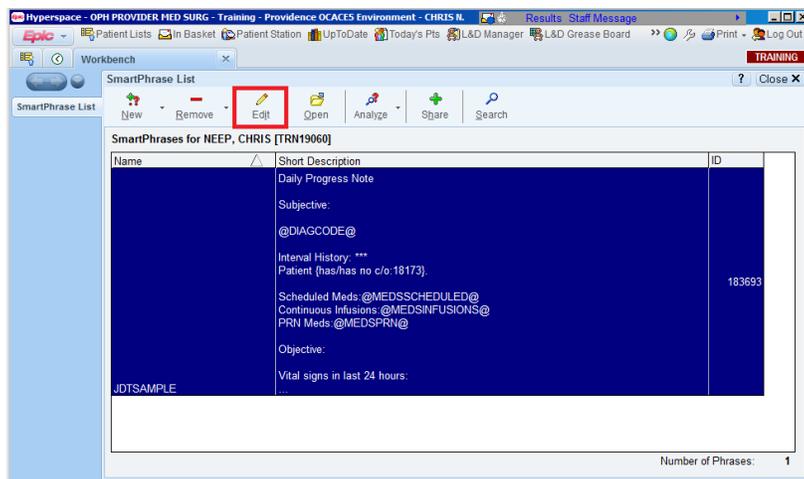


## Try It Out

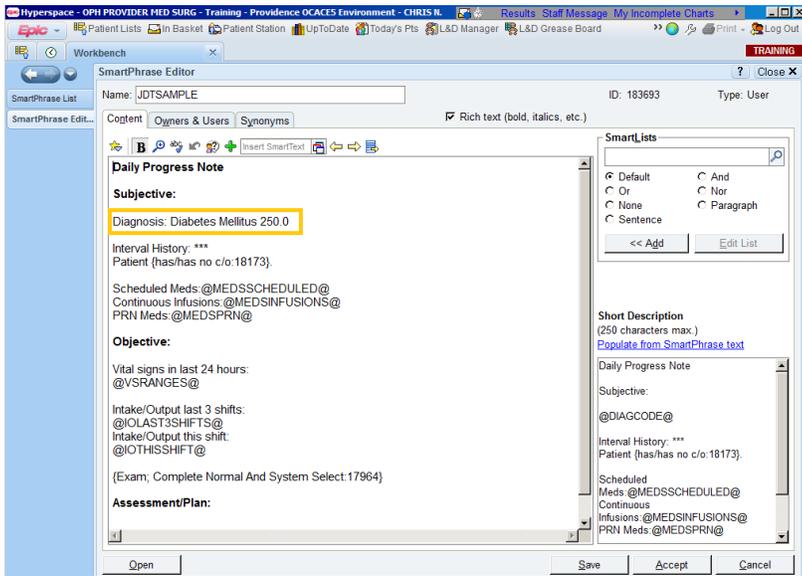
1. After logging in to Epic (from Patient Lists) click the **Epic** button.
2. The Epic menu opens. Click **Tools**.
3. An ICD-9 code for Diabetes Mellitus (250.00) needs to be removed from your customized SmartPhrase. Click **SmartPhrase Manager**.



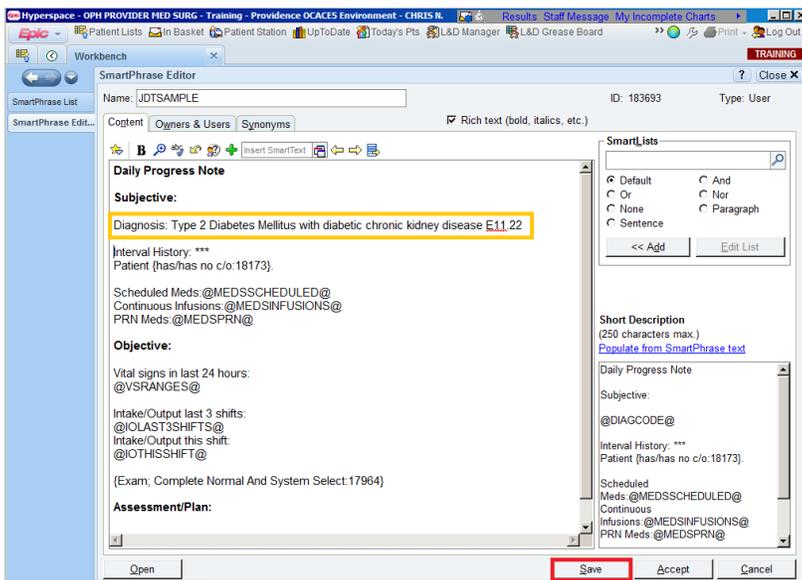
4. The SmartPhrase work bench opens. Click the **Edit** button.



- Locate and delete the ICD-9 diagnosis. Carefully consider whether an ICD-10 diagnosis should be added, and if so, add the appropriate code.



- Add the ICD-10 compliant diagnosis and click Save.



- The SmartPhrase has been updated with the ICD-10 code. Click the X to close the Workbench.
