

# Immunization Checklist

---

Welcome to Providence!

To protect you and our vulnerable patients the following health requirements **are required to be completed before starting your rotation/work at Providence:**

<p><b>Tuberculosis Testing</b> -- Quantiferon Gold (blood test for TB) current within the last 12 months or two negative Tuberculosis skin tests within the last 12 months.</p> <p>If history of positive PPD (skin testing) or Quantiferon IGRA (blood test) copies of chest x-rays, medical provider documentation and previous positive test results must be provided</p>
<p><b>Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)</b> – Documentation of 2 MMR vaccines and/or positive titers</p>
<p><b>Varicella (Chicken pox)</b> – Documentation of 2-varicella- vaccines and/or positive titer</p>
<p><b>Hepatitis B (Hep B)</b> - Documentation of Hep B vaccinations (series of 3) and/or positive titer for those caregivers who may be exposed to blood and body fluids</p>
<p><b>Tetanus, Diphtheria &amp; Pertussis (Tdap)</b> – Documentation of vaccination</p>
<p><b>Annual influenza vaccine</b> -- Documentation of acceptance or declination of the vaccine within the current season</p>

- If any of the above vaccines have been declined a signed declination will be required (see appropriate declinations provided)
- WWCC and WWU students/instructors – Your records will be provided to Providence St. Mary Medical Center on an audit basis per your facility. All records of Annual Influenza vaccinations/declinations will be shared with the medical center per your facility.
- All other students/caregivers – Your records must be provided to Providence St. Mary Medical Center Human Resources for review before initiation of rotation/work:
