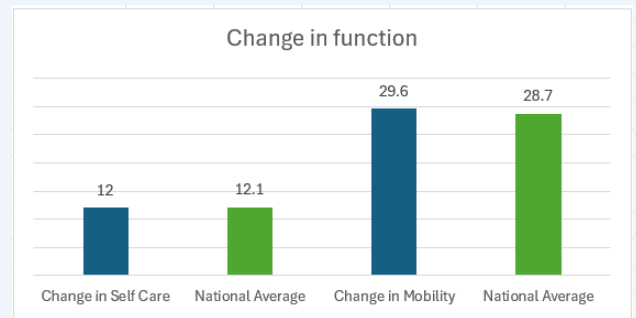
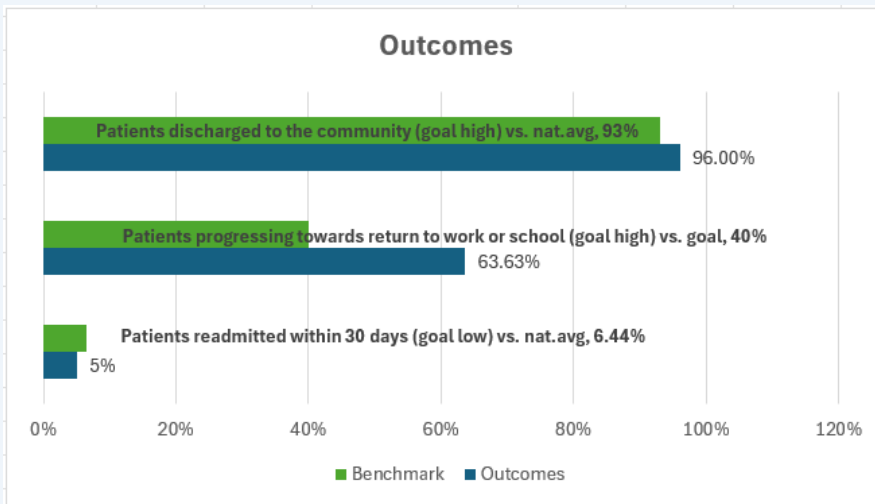




In 2025, patients with a brain injury had an average of **3.07 hours** of therapy each day **during a 5-day span**, as part of their inpatient rehabilitation at St. Luke's. Brain injury rehabilitation services are provided by St. Luke's specialized team of physicians, rehabilitation nurses, case managers, wound care nurses, dieticians, and therapy staff including physical, occupational, psychology, recreational, and speech therapy.

**Patient Outcomes** — based on a data from UDS (Uniform Data Systems) we achieved higher scores than the Nation in areas of Mobility and Discharge to Community, and helped patients prepare to return to work and school.
