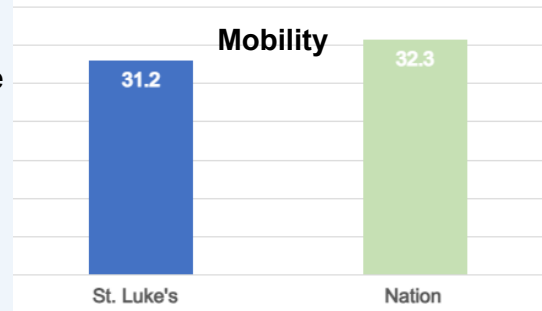


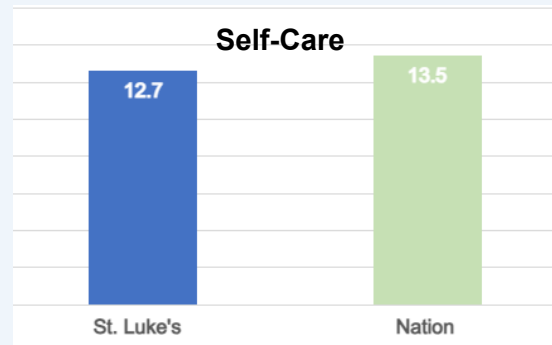


Our rehab program specializes in the treatment of a variety of conditions, aside from our specialty programs. In **2025**, our integrated team of physiatrists, nurses, therapists, psychologists, and case managers served **328** patients recovering from multi-trauma, cardiac

conditions, orthopedic injuries, debility and various neurological conditions including Parkinson's disease and Multiple Sclerosis, with an average length of stay of **10.9** days. We provide therapy services seven days per week, with patients receiving a daily average of **3.04** hours of therapy across their five-day rehabilitation week. This intensive approach ensures safe, efficient, and well-coordinated transitions home or to the next level of care. More than **86%** of patients were discharged to the community, increasing to over **95%** within 90 days post-discharge.

Our outcomes remain competitive with the nation as we work towards exceeding national performance.

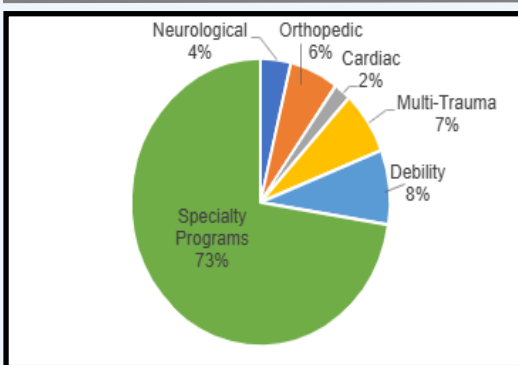
