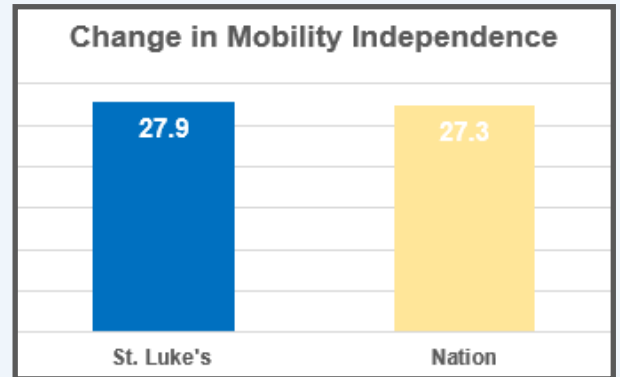


### Patients Served

Stroke can affect people of any age and at any stage of life. In 2025, **Providence St. Luke's Rehabilitation Medical Center** served nearly **600 stroke survivors**, with an average length of stay of **13.6 days**.

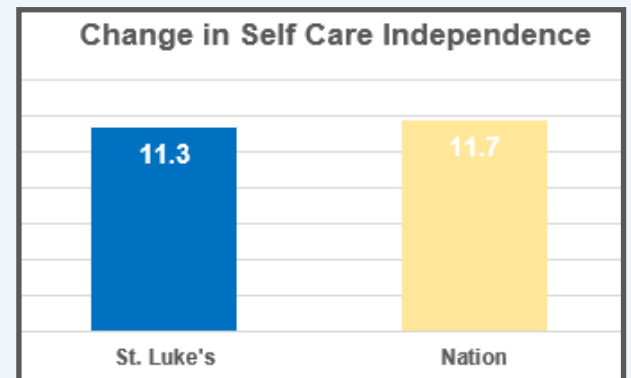
Our **comprehensive stroke rehabilitation program** is led by an interdisciplinary team of physicians, nurses, case managers, psychologists, and rehabilitation therapists, including physical, occupational, recreational, and speech therapists. Together, this team partners with patients and families to support recovery and a successful return home. In 2025, **83.7%** of patients discharged to the community, which increased to **93.5%** 90-days after discharge.

We provide therapy services 7 days per week, with patients receiving a daily average of **3.12 hours** of therapy across a five-day rehabilitation week- providing the intensity and consistency needed to maximize independence and improve quality of life after stroke.
