Frequently Asked Questions - Updated 2.1.22

- 1. What is happening and when? Beginning February 1, 2022, we will officially open at our new location as Providence Obstetrics & Gynecology. We will continue providing your care and the services you have come to know and trust from us, but under a new name and in a new location.
- 2. **Will I be able to see my same provider?** Yes, all providers have decided to join Providence to continue providing care.
 - Drs. Hechtman, Henderson, Messinger, Ruth, Satterfield and ARNPs Delger, Gray, Stuckrath and Wills will be starting a new practice: Providence Obstetrics & Gynecology.
 - Dr. Steven Richards will be joining Providence Surgical & Medical Gynecology to focus on gynecological services and surgeries. Dr. Richards will continue to provide gynecology services, including yearly check-ups.
- 3. Will I be able to receive the same services? Yes, we will continue to offer most of the same services that you have come to know and trust from us. We remain committed to the health of our patients throughout their lives and will continue to provide a wide range of services, including obstetric and gynecological care.
- 4. **Can I still access my contraception from Providence providers?** Yes, our providers prescribe contraception medications that the clinician and the patient determine are in the best interest of the patient's health needs.
- 5. What kind of changes can I expect? OB/GYN Associates of Spokane and Providence are committed to making this as smooth a transition as possible. One of the changes we are most excited about is the fact that we will be joining Providence's wide spectrum of women and children's services, including specialty baby and women's services, gynecologic surgeries and cancer care, high-risk pregnancy services, and the region's only Level IV NICU (highest level of care) and children's hospital.
- 6. Will there be changes to my insurance? Providence is contracted with most of the same insurance companies as OB/GYN Associates. Providence will complete insurance authorizations (insurance benefits) for all patients. Depending on your specific health plan, there may be a difference in coverage so we recommend reaching out to your insurance provider to verify. Our team works with you based on your unique situation.
- 7. Will I get separate bills? It is likely that if you are regularly seeing one of our providers that you will receive a statement from OB/GYN Associates for services received prior to February 1, 2022. Services provided after the transition will be on a statement from Providence. There will not be overlap in billing for services. Please note that beginning February 1, we can only accept credit cards for co-pays or payment.
- **8.** Who do I call if I have questions about a bill from OB/GYN Associates? For services provided before February 1, 2022, please call 509-623-1040. For services provided beginning February 1, please call Providence at 509-455-8866.
- How do I access my medical records from OB/GYN Associates? Please contact Providence at 509-455-8866 who will assist you in accessing your medical record. Please note that some costs may apply when requesting a full medical record.
- 10. Why did OB/GYN Associates decide to join Providence? We have long respected Providence as an organization and have partnered with their specialty teams and birth services at Sacred Heart Medical Center for many years. This transition allows us to continue providing great care for our patients while seamlessly increasing access to specialty care and other services for our patients.
